

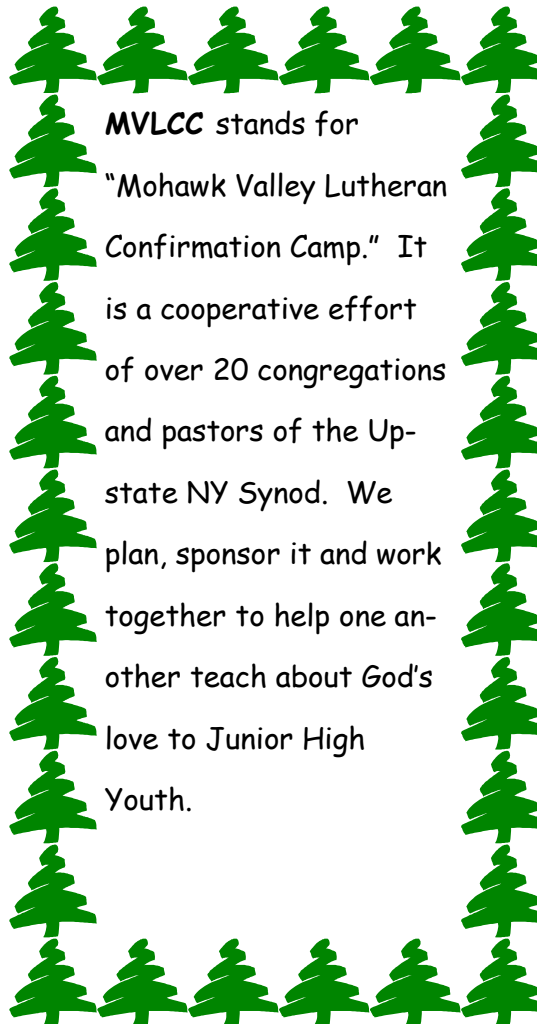
CAMPER CHALLENGE
